Tips and Strategies

Remember SCA™'s Main Concepts:

1. Acknowledging Competence

- "I know you know"
- Acknowlwedge Frustrations
- Speak Naturally

2. Revealing Competence

- Use gestures and key words
- Speak in simple sentences
- Ask "Yes"/"No" questions
- Give the patient time
