

Canadian Occupational Performance Measure (COPM©): integration Into the Acute Care Stroke Pathway



When rehab has been identified as the discharge disposition, initiate the COPM® before the patient leaves

For patients with cognitive or communication impairments determine if the patient is able to participate. If they are unable...



initiate the COPM© with a caregiver/family member who knows the patient well



document the reason for being unable to complete the COPM© (e.g. translation services unavailable)

STEPS TO COMPLETE THE COPM®



PrintPrint the COPM© from the references page of

E-Stroke*



Discuss

Discuss with the patient their current Occupational Performance Problem (OPP)



Ask

Ask them to rate their OPPs importance on a scale of 1-10



Ask

Ask the patient to identify their top 5 OPPs





Provide

Provide a completed copy of the COPM© to the patient



Complete

Complete local documentation requirements
