

# Canadian Occupational Performance Measure (COPM©): integration Into the Inpatient Rehabilitation Stroke Pathway



Complete the COPM© with **all** patients or caregivers



T1 should be completed within 72 hours of **admission** 

T2 should be completed within 72 hours of **discharge** 

For patients with cognitive or communication impairments determine if the patient is able to participate in the discussion. If they are unable...



Complete the COPM© with a caregiver/family member who knows the patient well



document the reason for being unable to complete the COPM© (e.g. translation services unavailable), <7days LOS)

# STEPS TO COMPLETE THE COPM®



#### **Obtain**

Obtain initiated COPM© from E-Stroke. If not initiated in acute care, initiate a COPM© with the patient (forms available on E-Stroke)



#### **Review & confirm**

Review and confirm identified OPPs from acute care. Edit and/or add additional OPPs if identified

Complete T2 performance and satisfaction scores prior to discharge\*\*





#### **Provide**

Provide a completed copy of the COPM® to the patient



## Complete

Complete local documentation requirements



### Input

Input COPM© results on E-Stroke

\*The E-Stroke copy of the COPM© has been approved by COPM© authors and can be included as part of the patient record.

\*\*Ensure the COPM© is completed by the same person (caregiver or patient) for the pre and post.
