

Canadian Occupational Performance Measure (COPM©): integration Into the Outpatient Rehabilitation Stroke Pathway

Complete the COPM© with **all** patients or caregivers



COPM© is completed as part of the **initial** and **discharge** assessment process.

For patients with cognitive or communication impairments determine if the patient is able to participate in the discussion.

If they are unable...



Complete the COPM© with a caregiver/family member who knows the patient well



document the reason for being unable to complete the COPM© (e.g. translation services unavailable), <7days LOS)

STEPS TO COMPLETE THE COPM®

for patients coming directly from acute care



Obtain

Obtain initiated COPM® from E-Stroke.



Review

Review identified OPPs from acute care and edit and/or add additional OPP's if identified



Complete

Complete T1
performance and
satisfaction score for
each OPP as part of the
admission assessment



Complete

Complete T2 performance and satisfaction scores prior to discharge**





Provide

Provide a completed copy of the COPM® to the patient



Complete

Complete local documentation requirements



Input

Input COPM© results on E-Stroke

*The E-Stroke copy of the COPM© has been approved by COPM© authors and can be included as part of the patient record.

**Ensure the COPM© is completed by the same person (caregiver or patient) for the pre and post.
