

# Canadian Occupational Performance Measure (COPM©): integration Into the Outpatient Rehabilitation Stroke Pathway

Complete the COPM© with **all** patients or caregivers



COPM© is completed as part of the **initial** and **discharge** assessment process.

For patients with cognitive or communication impairments determine if the patient is able to participate in the discussion.

If they are unable...



Complete the COPM© with a caregiver/family member who knows the patient well



document the reason for being unable to complete the COPM© (e.g. translation services unavailable), <7days LOS)

## STEPS TO COMPLETE THE COPM®

## for patients coming from inpatient rehab or no initiated COPM®



### **Initiate & Print**

Initiate a new COPM©

Print the COPM® from the references page of E-Stroke\*



#### **Discuss**

Discuss with the patient their current Occupational Performance Problem (OPPs) and ask them to rate the importance on a scale of 1 - 10.



#### **Ask**

Ask the patient to identify their top 5 OPPs

Complete T1
performance and
satisfaction score for
each OPP as part of the
admission assessment



#### **Provide**

Provide a completed copy of the COPM® to the patient

Complete local documentation requirements

Satisfaction

Complete T2 performance and satisfaction scores prior to discharge\*\*

- \*The E-Stroke copy of the COPM© has been approved by COPM© authors and can be included as part of the patient record.
  \*\*Ensure the COPM© is completed by the same person (caregiver or patient) for the pre and post.
